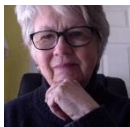

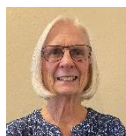


Editor's Extensions

We will have two dry runs before October 28, 2020 as follows:

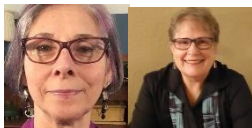
At 4:00 pm EST, Friday, October 23, 2020
