Class Gift/Endowment Fund Report Cynthia Neese Bailes, Co-Chair & Gift Fund Coordinator Celia May Laramie Baldwin, Gift Fund Co-Coordinator

Great news: We are now beginning to see our gift to Gallaudet in action! We now have yearly payouts drawing from the market value of our Mighty Class of 1970 endowments.

- The Student Scholarship Fund payout of \$2,211.63 has all been awarded as scholarships. We will receive the student information on in our FY2022 endowment report due out in Spring 2023.
- The Gannon Alumni fund payout of \$1,358.57 has not been spent; the funds have been rolled over for use in FY23.

Our last report in the February 2022 newsletter reflected the status of our funds as of 31 December 2021. Below is a table representing the status of our Class of 1970 endowment funds as of 30 September 2022, with a comparison based on our 31 December report.

You will see that the principal of each fund has grown because of continued donations. Thanks to those of you who continue to contribute to our two endowments. The principal of each fund will never increase; it will grow depending on our continuing contributions.

The decrease in market value in each fund reflects the financial market at the time of the report. The market value increases and decreases based on economic conditions. Let's all hope market conditions improved in 2023.
